

# Can I Report Data at a Different Geographic Level than What's Assigned?

**Situation:** Say your activity's indicator is defined with a district reporting level. This means that you must enter indicator results per district for one or more districts. Those districts must be **assigned to the activity** .

**Question:** Can you add a national total instead of reporting per district?

**Answer:** No.

**Explanation:** All indicators are defined with a single reporting level. You would need to either re-define your existing indicator to be reported nationally (which would apply to all activities that report on this indicator), or create a new indicator that is reported nationally. If you need two copies of an indicator to allow for two different reporting levels, you could get a total of the two by using a third **formula indicator** , where

- $\text{Ind1\_Total} = [\text{Ind1\_District}] + [\text{Ind1\_National}]$
